POTTERY & HOBBY CERAMICS

This general pottery course is designed to give you the opportunity for creative self-expression through the use of various media and techniques. You will use different types and colours of clay as well as, a variety of glazes and learn techniques such as coiling, slab-work, wheelwork and modelling. Clay glazes, tools and equipment will be provided. Within this structure there is room for great flexibility and you will be encouraged to follow your own interests.

Incorporated into this course we have “Hobby Ceramics”, introducing the techniques of the skilled potter through the simple yet professional means of moulds and related decorated media — ideal for the beginner! You will be able to produce decorative/functional pieces as ideal gifts or personal momentos’.

Beginners are as welcome as more experienced students. Some tools will be available to purchase from the Centre. The materials and equipment, which you may need, will be discussed at the first session.

Kiln firing of all work will be carried out by arrangement with the College Art Department. While every effort will be made to fire work without delay, there may be occasions when the firing of examination students’ work may take precedence.
