This course offers the recognised teaching qualification that will enable you to pursue a career as a teacher in the further education and training sector, which is predominantly students aged 16 and above.

Accredited by the University of Portsmouth the PGCE/CertEd is offered as a **part-time** programme at St Vincent College and is designed for teachers who currently work in the further education and training sector. The course encourages you to develop subject-specific knowledge by working closely with your course teachers and work-based subject mentors.

What opportunities might it lead to?

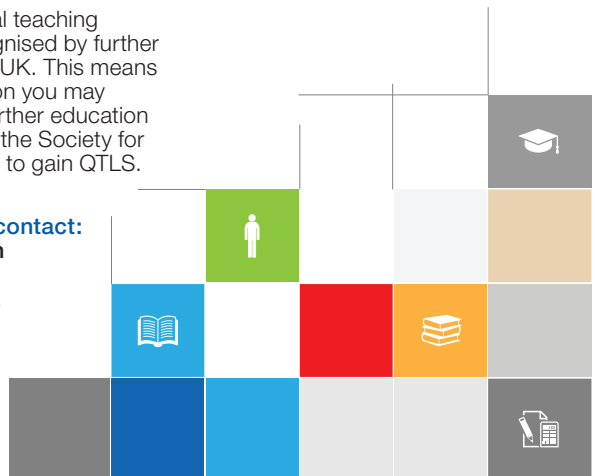
The PGCE/CertEd provides the skills and knowledge to take up teaching roles in further education environments, including:

The PGCE is a professional teaching qualification which is recognised by further education providers in the UK. This means upon successful completion you may gain employment with a further education provider and may apply to the Society for Education & Training (SET) to gain QTLS.
