If you have at least a year's experience in a learning support context, paid or voluntary, and the ability to study at this level you could work towards a nationally recognised qualification in your field.

Successful completion of this course allows you entry to an appropriate BA degree, such as the University of Portsmouth's BA (Hons) Education and Training Studies, at level three (i.e. the final stage). It may also be used as a stepping-stone to Qualified Teacher Status or to promotion in learning support roles.

- Share experiences in study groups with practitioners from a range of backgrounds
