Why take this course?

Do you wish to become an Early Years practitioner? This course is endorsed by the Early Years sector and can lead into an honours degree programme.

A key component of this degree is the application of the ideas and information you learn in the taught sessions to your workplace.

What opportunities might it lead to?

You will already be working within early years, on a paid or voluntary basis, when you begin this course. Your work-based learning will be developed and formalised in your studies with us. You may wish to consider progression to the Ba (Hons) Education Studies, a top-up degree from the FdA in Early Years Care and Education or Early Years Initial Teacher Training Programmes.

What will I experience?

On the course you will consider your practice and develop your knowledge in:

- Child development and learning
- Planning and organising the curriculum
- Working with others

There will also be opportunities to improve personal skills related to your work-based setting and academic requirements.

- NVQ Level 3 in Early Years or equivalent
- Functional skills English and Maths at Level 2 or GCSE English and Maths at Grade 4 or above
- Formal qualifications, life long learning and experience are also considered.
