Why take this course?

If you have at least one year's experience in a learning support context, paid or voluntary, and the ability to study at this level, you could work towards this nationally recognised qualification.

What opportunities might it lead to?

Successful completion of this course allows you entry to an appropriate BA degree, such as the University of Portsmouth's BA (Hons) Education, at level three (i.e. the final stage). It may also be used as a stepping-stone to Qualified Teacher Status or to promotion in learning support roles.

- Study alongside your existing learning support role (whether you are in a general or special educational needs setting; in a school, college or other institution)
- Share experiences in study groups with practitioners from a range of backgrounds
- On completion can gain entry to the BA (Hons) Education and Training programme at an advanced stage

- Functional Skills English and Maths at Level 2 or GCSE English and Maths at Grade 4 or above
- One year's experience in a learning support context (school or college), paid or voluntary
- A minimum of five hours per week currently working or volunteering in a learning support role
